

MASTER'S THESIS GUIDELINES

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND KINESIOLOGY

- I. Thesis Proposal
 - a. During a student's 1st semester of KAH 6983, a preliminary proposal plan should be submitted to the committee chair for review and approval.
 - b. The thesis committee is responsible for reviewing the proposal only; a formal proposal should be sent to the committee only after being approved by the student's thesis chair.

- II. Defense of Thesis
 - a. A formal, oral defense of the proposal is mandatory during the student's 1st semester of KAH 6983.
 - b. Other faculty members in addition to the thesis committee may attend the proposal defense.

- III. Length of Thesis
 - a. The proposal to the committee should be well-written and clear and require no more than one review by the committee.
 - b. Although the length of the thesis itself may vary, the thesis must be organized into chapter per university guidelines (see the graduate catalog for further details).
