

Guidelines for Undergraduate Health Degree Plan Substitutions

Department of Health and Kinesiology
(Revised on May 20, 2008)

I. Community College Courses

Any community college courses that have been previously approved by UTSA as fulfilling the requirements for a specific course should be approved. TCCN approvals are listed in the current UTSA undergraduate catalog.

II. Substitutions for University Core Curriculum, Degree Core and Designated Electives

Transfer substitutions will be allowed for certain courses that are similar to the UTSA course. The student must provide sufficient evidence of the nature and requirements of the course previously taken prior to submitting the substitution form (e.g. a course syllabus, a letter from the instructor of the course at another institution that is addressed to the UTSA Advising Office, or a course description from a catalog).

III. Substitution of Lower Division Course for Upper Division Courses

Accreditation standards prevent lower division courses from being substituted for upper division courses. A 1000 level course may not be substituted for a higher level course.

IV. Health Electives

The following are designated electives for Health. Other courses may be considered on a case-by-case basis. Lower division electives are limited to 12 credit hours. The courses listed below may not be offered every semester
